Our participants move into their homes with very little. They receive basic furniture from our Furniture Bank and bring the clothing and personal items they've been able to carry from place to place as they sleep unsheltered (sometimes for decades).

We provide necessities but often don't have the resources to provide a full move in kit for each participant. Donations of the following (brand new) items would allow every participant to have what they need to feel truly at home in their new apartment.

- Alarm clocks
- Bath towels and washcloths
- Brooms and dust pans
- Can openers
- Coffee makers
- Comforters or blankets
- Dinnerware sets
- Drinking glasses and coffee mugs
- Drying racks for dishes
- Flatware sets
- Food storage containers
- Full sheet sets
- Kitchen and bathroom trash cans
- Kitchen towels
- Plungers and toilet brushes
- Pot and pan sets
- Shower curtains and hooks
- Telephones
